Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent. This year, Ash Wednesday is on March 5th. Holy Communion begins at 7:00 p.m. On this day we confess our sins and receive ashes on our forehead as a sign of both our mortality and our repentance. During the 40 days of Lent (Sundays are not included), we carry out practices such as fasting, prayer, and works of love. Ash Wednesday is a kind of return to home and the great well of God's love and mercy. The ashes are marked in the sign of a cross, a sign of our baptism and new birth.

Journey to Easter begins in Lent. This process is a special time of preparation for those seeking Holy Baptism or Affirmation of Baptism. Through these events, people become new members but that is only secondary to the essentials. In the process people go deep in learning, prayer, and in building relationships with others in the congregation. Each person will be accompanied by a sponsor through this process and as a congregation we will pray for the candidates and their sponsors. Holy Baptism and reception of members will take place at the Easter Vigil.
