The Lectionary in Lent

This is the year of Matthew and we will hear Matthew’s account of Jesus’ temptation in the wilderness. After that the Sunday Gospels are all from John. They are incredible passages. Each of them is an encounter with Jesus. These readings were used to instruct catechumens in the early church. Each holds up a baptismal image that helps prepare candidates for baptism and all of us as we seek to renew our baptism at the Easter Vigil:

Second Sunday in Lent

- Being born again, John 3:1-17

Third Sunday in Lent

– Living Water, John 4:5-42

Fourth Sunday in Lent

– Illumination and anointing, John 9:1-41

Fifth Sunday in Lent

– Raising Lazarus from the tomb, John 11:2-45
